The Union Knows

- On Frenchay the temperature in many of the buildings is often too hot and windows need to be opened to make it a comfortable temperature, even in the winter.
- Heat is responsible for around a third of the UK's greenhouse gas emission.
- Being too hot makes it more difficult to concentrate on studying.
- Heating is costly.

The Unions Believes

- The University has a responsibility to make sure that's its buildings are conducive to studying.

- The money the University spends on unnecessary heating would be better spent elsewhere.
