

Improvements for Glenside Students

The Union Knows

- The buses between Frenchay and Glenside are extremely unreliable.
- The students living and studying at Glenside don't have immediate access to the same facilities as students at Frenchay.
- Fresher's no longer automatically have bus passes included with their accommodation like they did in previous years.
- Many Glenside students feel alienated from the University and the Students' Union.
- Glenside's Student Building opening hours are much shorter than those at Frenchay and is closed on weekend.
- The library at Glenside has shorter opening times than the one at Frenchay.
- The Glenside Students' Union building is outdated and in disrepair.
- Many popular student events happen only at Frenchay.
- Officer presence is low on Glenside.

The Unions Believes

- That a student's ability to make the most out of their Students' Union and University shouldn't be dependent on the campus they study on.

The Union Will

- Work with Glenside Students' and the University to create a project plan of how to improve facilities on campus.
- Work with the University to improve the transport between Frenchay and Glenside. Possibly through a free flyer service.
- Ensure that Officers especially Presidents are frequently at Glenside at known busy periods.
- Work to create equal access to popular events across campuses.
- Launch investigation into improving facilities at other satellite campuses.
