




66% of students are aware of the sustainable development goals at UWE




- The 3 issues that respondents least apply to sustainable development are cities, inequalities and infrastructure and industrialisation
- The 3 top issues are energy, water and sanitation and climate change



- 60% of respondents agree or strongly agree that Sustainable development is important for their employability.
- 92% of respondents agree or strongly agree that sustainable development is something which universities should actively incorporate and promote whilst 74% feel it should eb incorporated into all university courses
- 47% of respondents had a negative or neutral response to "sustainable development is something which all tutors should be required to incorporate within their teaching"
- 65% of students feel that sustainable development is relevant to their professional development whilst 62% feel it is relevant to their personal life
- 72% of students would like to learn more about sustainable development
- 66% would like to participate in sustainable development in the real world outside their course whilst 61% would like to participate as part of their university course.





- 27% of respondents want to engage with extra curricula activities so that they can learn new skills
- Only 12% of students want to engage with extra curricula activities so that they can share my knowledge/interest with other people
- 22% feel that engaging in extra-curricular activities would improve their CV
